

Young and old are fighting for two radically different visions of Britain. And both sides are willing to financially sabotage each other to get the result they want. This is according to a new poll of more than 3,000 people conducted by YouGov and The Challenge on behalf of the All Party Parliamentary Group (APPG) on social integration. The figures were part of a new report by the UK government's intergenerational integration committee and what divides Britain today. When Britons who voted to leave the European Union (EU) aged 55 and over were asked if they agreed with the following statement: I would agree to a lower wage for the next generation if it guaranteed an exit from the EU, a significant yes (26%) said, disagreed or disagreed with the statement, while 30% disagreed. The young Brits were not much kinder. When Britons aged 18-34 who voted to remain in the EU were asked if they agreed with the following statement: I would say, I would say pensions are for pensioners if that means ending Brexit, I agree. But, again, almost a third (28%) of those who do so said yes, and 16% said they disagreed or disagreed. A report entitled Ages Apart? The bond and separation between generations not only celebrate generational differences, but also explores how young and old can build intergenerational solidarity, and there is definitely a need for that, right now. The study found that the older generation considers millennials tainted, while young people perceive the elderly as mostly biased. When Britons aged 55 and over were asked if they agreed with the following statement that every generation should have a higher standard of living than it had before, 49% agreed, while 42% disagreed or disagreed. But when asked if they thought: Young adults have a sense of entitlement and are not willing to work hard for life, 67% agreed. Meanwhile, when remain voters aged 18-35 were asked if older people currently have an unfair share of wealth and income in the UK, 41% agreed, while 27% disagreed or disagreed. When asked if older people tended to be more biased against those from different races and genders, 73% agreed.
